<p>Phonics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We have now finished learning all the phonemes in reception. Yippee! • We have now finished learning all the tricky words in reception. Yippee! • We are learning about chunking words to help read and write {e.g. jump-ing} We are doing lots of segmenting and blending much longer words! 	<p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will look at number pairs within 10 and how we can create addition and subtraction problems from these. • Explore the composition of making 10 in different ways. • We will look at measuring length and weight. • Recognising numbers to 20 and beyond. 	<p>Religious Education</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be talking about special places to us – our homes, schools, Grandparents houses, churches, hugs in bed etc. • Some of us may go to church or a mosque, so we will discuss this in our sessions.
